2nd Baulkham Hills are the current reigning champions. Can your Patrol beat them?

Patrols need to source and supply their own meals for the weekend and must invite a "Celebrity Judge" (Leader) for dinner on Saturday night.
A campfire will be available for cooking if you like, and Saturday dinner will be part of the cooking competition.

Awards and Patrol Points:

This camp will be a friendly competition camp. Points will be awarded for various activities and achievements.

Scoring

Maximum 1,000 standard points, awarded as follows:

- 200 - Camp layout, management and construction
- 200 - Saturday dinner
- 100 - Sunday breakfast
- 100 - Camp gadgets
- 100 - Camp site inspection Saturday
- 100 - Camp site inspection Sunday
- 200 - Activity bases

Option 1) Patrols may travel by train to Newcastle and Hike in to Glenrock. Approx 5km, medium terrain.

POINTS AWARDED: 200 bonus points per patrol.

Packing Lists:

Pack for a 2 night standing camp with swimming.

If hiking in, ensure that your pack weight, including tents, does not exceed 25% of your body weight.

Optional items:

- \$5-\$10 for Maccas snack
- A dress-up or theme for your patrol

Equipment:

- Each Patrol must supply all of their own equipment including tents, shelters, lighting, cooking & utensils.
- Each Patrol must be self sufficient, however you may share some larger equipment (bbq, burner, etc) with other Patrols.

Sleeping Arrangements:

Youth:

- Scouts will sleep in tents organised by each Patrol.
- Patrol tents, Hike tents or Bivvy's may be used as preferred.
- Male & Female will sleep separately.

Adults:

- Leaders should supply their own tents and sleeping gear.

Meals & Dining:

- **Friday:** Please eat dinner before arriving at your hall or nag your driver for Maccas on the way.
- **Camping:** Each Patrol will receive \$20 per Scout to purchase food and supplies for the weekend.
- You also need to invite a Leader from another Troop to join you for Saturday dinner.
- Patrols need to source and supply their own meals for the weekend.
- Scouts will prepare and cook their own meals as a Patrol.

(Leader meals, other than Sat night, will be catered separately)

Activities:

Scouts will participate in a wide range of activities that may include: Swimming, Canoeing, Slip'n'slide, bushwalking, observation tasks, pioneering, construction & potato relocation or destruction.
